Tragedy was to strike again in World War II when Sybray Barker's eldest brother Henry (Harry) Barker (b 1889) & Minnie nee Bolam (b 1888) were to lose their second youngest son, Ivor Barker (b 1924). Ivor was in the Fleet Air Arm and became a prisoner of war after an air raid over Sumatra. On the day of the Japanese surrender he, together with eight other prisoners, was taken to the end of the island and illegally executed. Like Sybray, he too was aged 21yrs.
